The Labrador Retriever Club of the Potomac, begun Saturday, May 19, 1973, was not a spur of the moment venture. Our first effort, a fun match and obedience trial held on the property of John and Sandra Kelly, was the result of many discussions on the part of many different people over a period of years. Connie Barton broached the idea to me at the Tidewater Show in either '65 or '66. Subsequently Liz Clark, Dave McCurley, the late Dr. John S. Gordon, Ted Squires, Joan Reed, Helen Biggs, Joan Clarke and many others have argued to this purpose.

Two more recent events, however, directly triggered the gathering on Derby Day, 1973. They were receipt of a letter from the
Labrador Club, Inc. to Liz Clark indicating the Club's inability
to extend its efforts to improve the breed beyond its present
activities and, of course, the granting to the Labrador Retriever
Club of Southern California a license to hold a Speciality Show
and Obedience Trial under AKC rules.

Thus far, we have held two fun matches, a field and fun day and an educational forum with a panel of three distinguished English breeders and judges. In addition, the club has begun a breed newsletter and taken steps to support the two existing Labrador Specialty Shows. Our immediate schedule calls for a breed and obedience specialty match on the 16th of September and a training day on Monday, October 22.

At the present time, the club has established two primary goals:

1) Obtaining AKC recognition

2) Establishing a strong interrelated program of education and training for show, obedience and field.

We hope that our club will become the focal point for training, education and exchange of views between novice and experienced breeders and exhibitors in our area. We look toward affiliation with other Labrador independent specialty clubs, and we hope to someday affiliate in some manner with the Labrador Retriever Club, Inc., should the parent club one day revise its views toward local specialty clubs.

I believe that we have made a good start, but it is only a start. We must continue to press forward in what we have begun. The Board looks forward to your comments and our progress.

MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Mr. Leo G. Kinsella selected a lovely yellow bitch, Lownwoods Tarnstar Trust, owned and handled by Janet Churchill, as Best of Breed at LRCP's July 6 fun match at Springfield Farm, Middleburg, Virginia. The Club had the use of Mrs. Clark's lovely estate grounds and her generous hospitality at the pool-side meeting that followed the evening match. A lively and interesting discussion with three distinguished English breeders and judges, Dyana Beckett, and Miriam and Leo Kinsella, followed.

Linda Anderson's 9-12 black male Joallamar's Churchill was Best Puppy. Best Opposite was Sylvia Fisher's black Bravo's Ebony Trooper. Mr. Kinsella had an excellent entry of 53, and his critique will be published in a later edition of the newsletter along with an account of the obedience match, which ably

judged by Dick and Virginia Ganett.

Our initial match was judged by Ted Squires, who selected Sylvia Fisher's Bravo's Ebony Trooper, C.D.X., as Best of Breed. Trooper was also among the top scorers at the obedience match. Best of Opposite Sex was Janet Churchill's black bitch Spenrock Boomerang. Pest Puppy went to Beth Sweigart's black bitch Bravo's Pandora of Yarrow. There was a total entry of 87 at the match held in Potomac, Md. This represented 74 dogs, with 54 entries in breed and a pleasingly large 33 entries in obedience.

The Isaac Walton League grounds in Rockville, Md., were the site for the field training and fun day, Saturday, August 4. Barbara Starkey and Sylvia Fisher ran the split sessions. The morning field workshop was aided immensely by Bryan McCreesh, President of the Maryland Retriever Club, his wife Carolyn and Ted Catchings, who shepherded three groups: puppies, beginners and intermediate. Ted's stylish worker, Joy, started the day by showing how a good retriever should take a land-water couble and an over-the-hill blind retrieve. Special thanks go to Joe May for providing us with hard-to-get pigeons for use in the field training.

Thirty-one people entered 45 dogs in LRCP's first field training session. Everyone agreed that Barbara and her people

did a tremendous job.

After lunch Sylvia set up a full obedience demonstration. All classes of obedience work were represented: sub-novice, novice, open and utility. Just to show we are not prejudiced, Nat Horn demonstrated tracking with his Chesapeake Bay, Ch. Easter Waters Thunderchief, C.D., T.D.

Dr. Dan Horn of the Eastern Waters prefix and thus father to both Nat and Tounderchief, teamed with Cathy-Lou Bragaw in a

show handling class which topped the day.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary, and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person; or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i. e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, particolor), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Fox Terriers (smooth, wire), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i. e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 3. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 16, Section 3.)


